

Scheduled Data Feed Service Supplement

This Scheduled Data Feed Service Supplement (“SDF Supplement”) forms part of the Agreement between Customer and Sensor Tower. Capitalized terms used but not defined herein have the meanings given in the Agreement or in this SDF Supplement.

1. Definitions.

A. “Documentation” means the documents made available by Sensor Tower to Customer that describe the SDF Service.

B. “Cloud Storage Provider” means the entity that provides the Cloud Storage Target.

C. “Cloud Storage Target” means the cloud storage location controlled by Customer and listed on the Order Form designated to receive Service Data via Push as part of the SDF Service.

D. “Cloud Storage Target Region” means the region in which the Cloud Storage Target is located.

E. “Push” means the transfer of Service Data by Sensor Tower to Customer’s Cloud Storage Target as part of the SDF Service.

2. Usage Rights, Provisioning, Availability.

A. As set forth in the Order Form and Documentation, Sensor Tower will Push the selected Service Data to the Cloud Storage Target for use by Customer. All rights, restrictions, and limitations applicable to the Service Data (and Customer’s access to and use thereof) remain as set forth in the Agreement. Only Service Data subscribed to by Customer as part of a primary Sensor Tower Service (i.e., App Performance Insights or Pathmatics) and selected in the Order Form will be provided via the SDF Service.

B. Customer shall provide to Sensor Tower the Cloud Storage Provider and region, Cloud Storage Target identifier, connection credentials, and any other information Sensor Tower may reasonably require to Push to Customer’s Cloud Storage Target.

C. Customer acknowledges that some Service Data included in the Sensor Tower web portal may not be available via the SDF Service, and that the availability of the SDF Service depends on the designated Cloud Storage Target (including the Cloud Storage Provider and Cloud Storage Target Region).

3. Cloud Storage Target Subscription.

Customer is responsible for maintaining a subscription to and the availability of the Cloud Storage Target to receive Service Data via Push hereunder (including by configuring the Cloud Storage Target to accept Service Data via Push). Customer’s subscription to the Cloud Storage Target is subject to and governed by the terms of a separate agreement between Customer and the Cloud Storage Provider. Customer acknowledges that using the SDF Service to receive and use the Service Data on the Cloud Storage Target may cause Customer to incur fees with the Cloud Storage Provider, and Customer is solely responsible for the payment of any such fees. Sensor Tower does not license, support, control, endorse or otherwise make any representations or warranties regarding, and shall have no liability associated with, the Cloud Storage Target or the Service Data’s suitability for use on the Cloud Storage Target. In no event will any Cloud Storage Provider products or services (including the Cloud Storage Target) be considered “Services” for purposes of this SDF Supplement or the Agreement. The SDF Service is not necessary or required for use of any other Sensor Tower Service(s).

4. POC.

Customer agrees to designate a technical point of contact ("POC") to support collaboration during the Setup Period and ongoing maintenance after go-live. The designated POC, including name and email, must be provided within 7 days of the effective date of the Agreement if not specified in the applicable Order Form.

5. General.

Customer acknowledges that the Agreement, which includes this SDF Supplement, applies in full force to the Service(s) including the SDF Service. Sections 2 and 3 of this SDF Supplement survive termination or expiration of the Agreement.
