

Unified Data Share for Snowflake Service Supplement

This Unified Data Share for Snowflake Service Supplement (“UDSS Supplement”) forms part of the Agreement between Customer and Sensor Tower. Capitalized terms used but not defined herein have the meanings given in the Agreement or in this UDSS Supplement.

1. Definitions.

- A. “Snowflake” means Snowflake, Inc. (or its affiliates, licensors, successors, or resellers, as applicable).
- B. “Snowflake Account” means an account owned or controlled by Customer for use of the Snowflake Platform.
- C. “Snowflake Platform” means any platform or service provided by or on behalf of Snowflake with which the UDSS Service interfaces, as described in Snowflake’s documentation.

2. Usage Rights, Provisioning, Availability.

- A. Subject to the terms of the Agreement, Sensor Tower grants to Customer a non-exclusive, non-transferable, world-wide right to access and use the Service Data within Customer’s Snowflake Account(s). Except as expressly provided in the preceding sentence, all rights, restrictions, and limitations applicable to the Service Data (and Customer’s access to and use thereof) remain as set forth in the Agreement.
- B. Customer shall provide its Snowflake Account ID(s) and corresponding Snowflake region(s), and any other information Sensor Tower may reasonably require, so that Sensor Tower may enable provision of the Service Data within Customer’s Snowflake Account.
- C. Customer acknowledges that some Service Data included in the Sensor Tower web portal may not be available via the UDSS Service, and that Service Data availability may additionally be dependent upon the Snowflake region selected by Customer.

3. Snowflake Platform; Snowflake Account.

Customer is responsible for maintaining a Snowflake Account enabling its use of the Snowflake Platform, which is subject to and governed by the terms of a separate agreement between Customer and Snowflake. Customer acknowledges that utilizing the UDSS Service to receive and use the Service Data on the Snowflake Platform may cause Customer to incur fees with Snowflake, and Customer is solely responsible for the payment of any such fees. Sensor Tower does not license, support, control, endorse or otherwise make any representations or warranties regarding, and shall have no liability associated with, the Snowflake Platform or the Service Data’s suitability for use on the Snowflake Platform. In no event will any Snowflake product or service (including the Snowflake Platform) be considered “Service” for purposes of this UDSS Supplement or the Agreement. The UDSS Service is not necessary or required for use of any other Sensor Tower Service(s).

4. General.

Customer acknowledges that the Agreement, which includes this UDSS Supplement, applies in full force to the Service(s) including the UDSS Service. Sections 2 and 3 of this UDSS Supplement survive termination or expiration of the Agreement.
